Jim Dine (b. 1935)

Jim Dine's prolific career as printmaker, painter and sculptor has spanned over six decades; his iconic images are internationally renowned. Born in Cincinnati, Ohio, he studied at night at the Cincinnati Art Academy before attending the University of Cincinnati; the School of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston; and Ohio University, from which he received his BFA in 1957. Dine moved to New York in 1959 and became a pioneer creator of 'Happenings' together with Allan Kaprow, Claes Oldenburg, and Robert Whitman. Since his first solo exhibition in 1960, Dine has been the subject of nearly 300 solo exhibitions worldwide. Print retrospectives of his work include the Whitney Museum of American Art, New York, the National Gallery Victoria, Australia and the Albertina, Vienna. He lives and works in Paris and Walla Walla, Washington.
