Joan Miró (1893 - 1983)

Joan Miró was born in Barcelona in 1893. He trained at Escuela de Bellas Artes de la Llotja, and Escuela de Arte de Francesco Galí Circulo Artístico de Sant Lluc in Barcelona, before moving to Paris in 1920. He became a member of 'Generation 27'; an influential Surrealist group of Spanish poets and artists. He spent a lot of time in his life travelling between his homes in Barcelona and Paris, where he worked on painting and developing his printing technique. Miro is now recognised as one of the most influential artists of the 20th century and his work has been interpreted as Surrealism, a sandbox for the subconscious mind, a re-creation of the childlike and a manifestation of Catalan pride. Miró died in Palma, Majorca in 1983.
