Artist Biography

Etel Adnan (1925 - 2021)

Etel Adnan (1925 - 2021), poet, writer and painter, was born in Beirut, Lebanon. She studied philosophy at the Sorbonne, Paris, and in 1955, she moved to the USA to pursue post-graduate studies at the University of California, Berkeley and Harvard. Acclaimed throughout her life for her writing, Adnan started painting in the 1960s, prompted by the violence of the Algerian War (1954-62) but it was not until her inclusion in Documenta 13, Germany, in 2012 that she came to prominence as a visual artist. Adnan's work explores the political and personal dimensions of violence and exile from familiar landscapes and languages. Her abstracted works are suggestive of landscapes and include forms that reference specific places, often painted from memory. Adnan made paintings, drawings, and tapestries. She incorporated printmaking into her practice in the final years of her life.
